Prayer Pointers

- Pray for families awaiting an Education Statement that will ensure that their child has the right support to make progress in school – often a difficult process. Pray that sufficient funding, care and the right specialist teaching will be made available for them.
- *Heavenly Father, please encourage and equip those involved in the education of children and adults who have special needs, at home, in mainstream and special schools: parents and other family members, carers, therapists, teachers, befrienders, medical professionals and many others. Amen.*
- Remember the 45,000 deaf children in the UK, 40 per cent of whom have additional special needs. Ask God to help their parents – very few are deaf themselves – to understand and to access the best education so that their children can have every opportunity to fulfil their potential.
- Intercede for families with disabled children in the poorest parts of the world who are unlikely to thrive, or be given an education. Pray for Christian initiatives that provide equipment, special schooling, orphanages, training programmes and other projects offering hope and opportunity.
- Pray for Alice in all that she does as Children and Family worker in the community.
- Pray for the plans for the Easter Fund Day—that we would have good team of folks contributing to the day and it will be a positive and fun filled day.
